Plans are underway for our Fall Symposium and Bulb Sale. In the past it has been held at the New Hope United Methodist Church in Des Moines. We have an opportunity to hold the Symposium at the Greater Des Moines Botanical Gardens on November 2, 2024. Several IRLS members present at the Spring Garden Market at the Botanical Gardens in May had the chance to talk to folks from the Botanical Gardens about the possibility of using their facility for the Symposium, meetings and even the Show.

The advantages of having the Symposium at the Botanical Gardens are that we would have greater exposure to the public, they would advertise for us, and we would be able to sell bulbs to the public as well as share our member bulbs. We would like to bring in a lily expert as the keynote speaker, so Kris Jurik will be talking to the Lily Experts at NALS in Minnesota in July to see who we can invite.

Some of the topics that have been suggested are:

- Diseases of lilies Botrytis, Viruses
- Lily Beetle Sightings
- Climate Change Effect on Lilies
- New Lily Varieties
- Propagating lilies
- Hybridizing lilies
- Preparing lilies for the Show

- Virtual Education available from NALS

We plan to have the member bulb exchange and bulb sale in conjunction with the Symposium so make sure your lilies are labeled when they bloom so you know which varieties you will be able to share.
